New WEEPI Foundation call for proposals!

The WEEPI Foundation has launched a call for proposals for a **new round of Stage 1 projects** focusing on clinical or implementation research aimed at improving the quality of care for people living with HIV, viral hepatitis or tuberculosis in Central and Eastern Europe.

Organizations and institutions from that region can apply for up to CHF 30,000 for Stage 1 projects that form the basis for subsequently applying for a larger Stage 2 project.
