



Progress towards reaching the SDGs





- Curb the flow on new infections
- Scale up prevention programmes (incl. OST/NSP, PrEP)
- 1 in 5 PLHIV in Europe are unaware of their HIV status
- 1 in 2 people are diagnosed late
- Low testing coverage

- 1 in 3 PLHIV not on ART
- Implement EACS treatment guidelines
- Provide ART to ALL

Major gaps in our understanding of stigma, both among HCW and in the community How could we proceed to better monitor HIV stigma & discrimination in the community and in the healthcare setting?




Survey promotion

from 54 countries in Europe










How satisfied are you with your life?*






*Scale 0-10, where 0 is not at all satisfied and 10 is completely satisfied



Experience of stigma by markers of depression within last 2 weeks




Self-stigma of respondents






Proportion of respondents who have never told any family member, friend, or current sexual partner about their HIV status






Experiences of stigma from friends, family or sexual partners, by how recently the experience occurred

Experiences of stigma by Life Satisfaction Score




Experiences of stigma in dental care, by how recently the experience occurred





Experiences of stigma within the justice system, by how recently the experience occurred






Percentage of respondents

Conclusions



- First time we have European-wide data on experienced stigma among PLHIV
- 1 in 5 PLHIV have not told a single friend
- 1 in 3 have not told a single family member
- High levels of experienced stigma from 'family and friends', and even higher levels of experienced stigma in 'healthcare settings'

that they were living with HIV

 In general, PLHIV are concerned/worried about being treated differently because of their HIV status, and this affects disclosure to family/friends/sexual partners and health seeking behaviour – ultimately affecting their quality of life

HIV-related stigma is highly prevalent and more efforts are needed to address stigma in order to improve the quality of life of people living with HIV
