# How to increase HIV testing Launch of tools developed to optimise

HIV testing and linkage to care

## Time and venue:

20:30 – 22:30h, 25 July 2017, Salon Marceau, Hotel InterContinental, 64 Avenue Marceau, Paris

#### Background:

The multidisciplinary collaborative EU co-financed project Optimising testing and linkage to care for HIV across Europe – OptTEST – is coming to an end after 3 years of intensive work.

#### The work has been focused on four areas:

- Analysing data on linkage to HIV treatment and care and improving collaborations on national level
- Developing tools to facilitate implementation of indicator condition (IC) guided HIV testing in primary care and other clinics
- Modelling the cost-effectiveness of different HIV testing approaches
- Developing tools on how best to address stigma and legal and regulatory barriers to HIV testing

The developed tools and examples of their implementation will be presented at this reception.

## **Other OptTEST meetings and events**

### National Stakeholder Meeting, Lisbon, Portugal

On 5 and 6 June OptTEST by HiE, GAT (Group of Treatment Activists in Portugal) and Ser+ (Association to prevent and challenge HIV/AIDS) brought together community, clinicians, officials from regional health institutions and the Ministry of Health in Lisbon for a round-table on steps to be taken to ensure the smooth and effective implementation of testing in primary care in Portugal, and to improve linkage to care of key populations. The discussion was set in the context of an update in guidelines and served to build consensus on issues to be addressed, and possible remedies among actors in civil society, health professionals and public health institutions representatives. #### Meeting in Barcelona on 10th of July

On 10 July a meeting will take place in Barcelona, Spain on improving early diagnosis of HIV in primary care in Catalonia and Europe.
